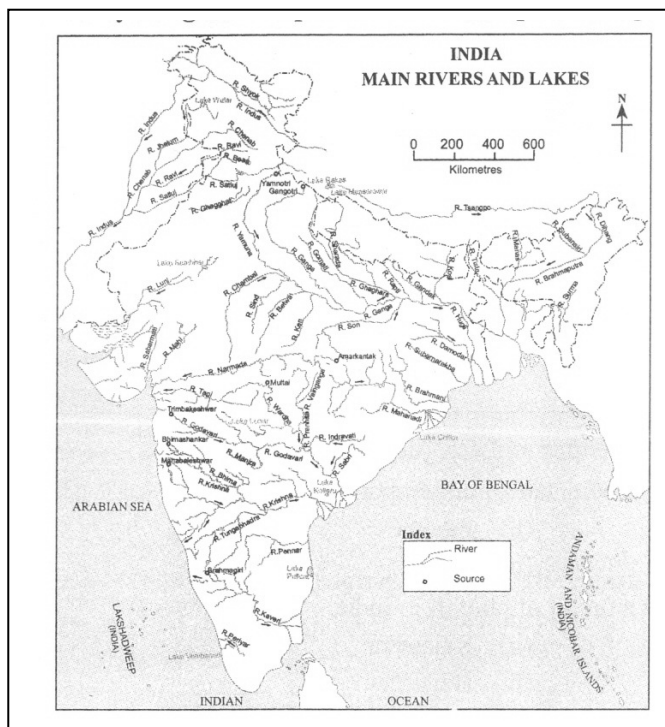

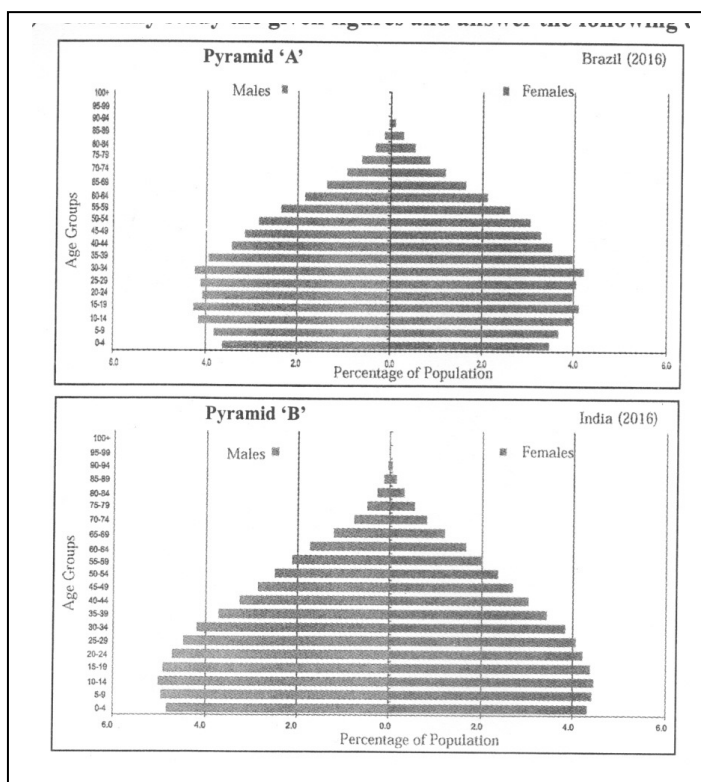
**Average Monthly Rainfall in India**
